To protect and conserve biodiversity & habitats. 2. To assess the impacts during construction, post construction of the project roads on forest, wildlife and wildlife habitat. 3. To identify areas of forestry/wildlife –traffic conflict that could create fatal accidents or loss of wildlife or forest resources during construction & post construction of project roads. 4. To identify areas of wildlife crossings, its species and reason for crossings for each location need to be explored. 5. To workout/evolve modified/improved Cross- Drainage (CD) structures or bridges as mitigation measures for wildlife crossings. 6. To evolve innovative long term and short term road strategies or plans to mitigate/ reduce the forestry/wildlife –traffic conflicts/collisions for a safe road network. 7. Prepare road wise concrete proposal with budgetary requirements, unit rate analysis to integrate into the engineering plans for building or integrating such plans to the contractors work during implementation of the project.
