  - (III) Part III comprises of Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of 90 questions [From Social Science, Basic Science, Language (Hindi & English) & Mathematics.]
- 6. Time for Part I is 45 minutes, for Part II 45 minutes and for Part III 90 minutes.
- 7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark and there will be no negative marking.
- 8. Write your Roll Number and Centre Code Number as given in the Admit Card on the Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the question Booklet in the space provided.
- 9. **DO NOT** Write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
- 10. All Questions in the booklets are of objective type. For each question there are **four options** of which only one is correct. Your task is to find out the **correct option** and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.

# NATIONAL MEANS-cum-MERIT SCHOLARSHIP (NMMS) 2015 (Date of Exam: 2nd November, 2014 (Sunday)

- Ministry of Human Resource and Development has launched National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme to award 1,00,000 scholarships to the meritorious students whose parental income is less than Rs. 1.5 lakh per year.
- Himachal Pradesh has been allotted quota of 832 schloarships out of which 15% scholarships will be alloted to SC, 7.5% to ST and 3% to Physically Challanged Group (PCG)/SWSN (Children with special needs)
- The scholarship will be paid from class IX to XII. The amount of scholarship is Rs. 500/- (Per month) subject to the condition that he/she secures 55% or more marks in 8th, 9th, 10+1 & 60% in class 10th. Relaxable by 5% for SC/ST/PCG. The awardee of the Scholarship has to continue his/her education only in Govt./Local Body/Govt. aided private schools.

## **Eligibility Conditions:**

- Any regular student of class VIII in academic session 2012-13 can appear provided he/she has secured 55% or more marks in aggregate in Class VII relaxable by 5% for SC/ST/PCG.
- The student should be studying in Govt./Local Body/Govt. aided private schools.
- The parental income of the candidate should be less than Rs. 1,50,000/- per year (Income certificate issued by SDM/Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar must be attached in original).

#### Documents to be sent :

- Application form duly signed by candidate and verified by head of the School along with Admit Card.
- 2. Detail marks sheet of 7<sup>th</sup> Class Examination.
- 3. Income certificate issued by SDM/Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar in Original.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST must attach attested copy of SC/ST certificate issued by SDM/ Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar.
- Candidates belonging to CWSN Category (Children with special need) should attached photo copy of the Certificate issued by CMO (Chief Medical Officer) The extent of physically disability should be 40% or above.
- 6. A self addressed stamped envelop bearing stamps of Rs. 5/- be attachd with the application form otherwise admission card will not be sent.
- Selection process for the award of NMMS scholarship has one stage only

The Examination will comprise of three tests namely MENTAL ABILITY (MAT), Language Test and

#### SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST (SAT)

- MAT will judge the power of reasoning, ability to think and judge, evaluate or discriminate etc.
- SAT will consist of Social Science, Basic science and Mathematics.
- MAT will be of 50 Marks (45 Min.) Language Test will be of 40 Marks (45 Min.)
- There will be no negative marking.

The minimum qualifying marks for general category candidates shall be 40% and for SC/ST/PCG is

• 32%

The scholarship shall be awarded to those selected candidates who secure 55% or more marks in class VIII. There will be relaxation of 5% for SC/ST/PCG.

# राष्ट्रीय साधन एवं योग्यता छात्रवृति - 2014

परीक्षा तिथि : 2 नवम्बर, 2014 (रविवार)

- केन्द्रीय मानव संसाधन विकास मंत्रालय ने 1,00,000 छात्रों को छात्रवृतियां प्रदान करने के लिए राष्ट्रीय साधन एवं पात्रता छात्रवृति योजना का प्रारम्भ किया है । इस छात्रवृति के लिए हर वर्ष एक परीक्षा का आयोजन किया जाता है । परीक्षा में बैठने के लिए वही छात्र पात्र होंगे जिनके माता-पिता की वार्षिक आय 1,50,000 रूपए से कम होगी ।
- इस योजना के अन्तर्गत हर वर्ष हिमाचल प्रदेश के 832 छात्रों को छात्रवृति मिल सकेगी । 15 प्रतिशत छात्रवृतियां अनुसूचित जाति के छात्रों के लिए, 7.5 प्रतिशत अनस्चित जनजाति के छात्रों के लिए और 3 प्रतिशत शारीरिक रूप से अक्षम छात्रों के लिए आरक्षित है ।
- छात्रवृति नौवीं कक्षा से 12वीं कक्षा अर्थात 4 वर्ष के लिए देय होगी । छात्रवृति की राशि 500 / रूपए प्रति माह होगी, शर्त यह है कि छात्रा / छात्र 8वीं, 9वीं, 11वीं कक्षाओं की वार्षिक परीक्षाओं में 55 प्रतिशत अंक तथा 10वीं में 60 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करें । आरक्षित वर्ग के लिए 5 प्रतिशत की छूट होगी । विद्यार्थी केवल सरकारी, स्थानीय निकाय द्वारा संचालित अथवा सरकारी सहायता प्राप्त स्कूल में ही 4 वर्ष तक शिक्षा ग्रहण कर रहा हो ।

#### पात्रता :

- सत्र 2014-15 में 8वीं कक्षा में पढ़ रहा कोई भी नियमित छात्र जिसने 7वीं कक्षा में 55 प्रतिशत अंक या अधिक अंक लेकर पास की हो,
   परीक्षा में बैठने के लिए पात्र है । आरक्षित वर्ग के लिए 5 प्रतिशत की छूट होगी अर्थात 50 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करने वाला छात्र भी इस परीक्षा में बैठ सकेगा ।
- छात्र किसी भी सरकारी, स्थानीय निकाय द्वारा संचालित अथवा सरकारी सहायता प्राप्त स्कूल 95 प्रतिशत सरकारी सहायता से, शिक्षा ग्रहण कर रहा हो ।
- छात्र के माता-पिता की सभी स्रोतों से वार्षिक आय 1,50,000/- रूपए से कम हो । उपमण्डलाधिकारी नागरिक, तहसीलदार अथवा किसी कार्यकारी मैजिस्ट्रेट द्वारा जारी आय प्रमाण-पत्र की मुल प्रति आवेदन के साथ संलग्न करें । अन्यथा पात्रता स्वीकार नहीं की जाएगी ।
- अनुसूचित जाति / जनजाति के उम्मीदवार छात्र उपमण्डल अधिकारी नागरिक, तहसीलदार अथवा किसी कार्यकारी मैजिस्ट्रेट द्वारा जारी प्रमाण-पत्र की अनुप्रमाणित Attested) छायाप्रति आवेदन के साथ संलग्न करें ।
- शारीरिक रूप से अक्षम उम्मीदवार छात्र मुख्य जिला चिकित्सा अधिकारी द्वारा जारी इस आश्य का प्रमाण-पत्र संलग्न करें । शारीरिक अक्षमता
   40 प्रतिशत अथवा इससे अधिक हो ।
- 5 / रूपए का डाक टिकट लगा अपना पता सिंहत लिखा लिफाफा आवेदन के साथ संलग्न करें अन्यथा परीक्षा के लिए प्रवेश-पत्र नहीं भेजा जाएगा ।

   इस छात्रवृति के लिए चयन प्रक्रिया एक ही चरण में समाप्त होगी ।

#### चयन प्रक्रिया

- परीक्षा के लिए 3 तरह के टैस्ट निर्धारित किए गए हैं बौद्धिक योग्यता परीक्षा, भाषा परीक्षा तथा शैक्षिक योग्यता परीक्षा ।
   बौद्धिक योग्यता परीक्षा में छात्र की तर्क शक्ति, सोचने, निर्णय लेने, मूल्यांकन, और अन्तर इत्यादि करने की योग्यता का परीक्षण किया जाएगा ।
- नकारात्मक मृल्यांकन नहीं होगा ।
- सामान्य श्रेणी के उम्मीदवार को न्यूनतम 40 प्रतिशत और आरक्षित श्रेणियों के लिए न्यूनतम 32 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करने होंगे ।
- छात्रवृति उन्हीं छात्र / छात्राओं को देय होगी जो 8वीं कक्षा और उसके बाद की वार्षिक परीक्षाओं में नियुनतम 55 प्रतिशत अंक और 10वीं
   परीक्षा में 60 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करेंगे जिसमें कि आरक्षित वर्ग के लिए 5 प्रतिशत की छूट है ।
