7. Functions of the Society:

- 1. To undertake activities pertaining to Tribal Bhawan and Community Hall Bhawan improvement directed towards welfare of the visitors.
- 2. To ensure better stay and device methods to enable the Tribal Bhawan and Community Hall Bhawan to generate its own resources.
- 3. To create, recruit and manage staff in the Society and to make payments to such personnel in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Society.

The audit report shall be placed before the General Body every year as soon as it has been finalized. Such a report shall also be submitted to Govt. of H.P. as and when required.

7. To enter into agreement, contract or correspondence with any individual, company, society, NGO, Govt. etc. in order to further the objectives of the Society from time to time.

If on winding up of the society due to any reason there remains some assets or properties in whatever manner, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Society or any of their relations but shall be dealt with in such manner as may be prescribed by the State Government provided, however, that the debts and liabilities shall be the first charge of the properties of the Society.

Amendments of Bye-Laws: 20.

These bye-laws will be subject to such amendments as may be carried out with the approval by a majority of three-fifth Members of the General Body from time to time and strictly in consonance with the provision of the H.P. Societies Registration Act. 2006.

Legal Matters: 21.

In case of legal proceedings by or against the society the Member Secretary shall be authorized to file or sign affidavits, file replies, produce documents etc. on behalf of the society and shall also appear in various courts or before other authorities. He shall also be entitled to get such legal assistance as may be required and expenditure incurred from the funds of the society. All such pleadings, statements, replies shall have approval of the Governing Body.

23. Savings:

The present society shall be deemed to have been constituted under these rules and all regulations framed by it shall be deemed to have been framed under these rules and regulations.

Power to Relax:

In case of any interpretation, clarification etc. the same shall rest with the Govt. of H.P. i.e. Pr. Secretary (TD) to the Govt. of H.P. shall have the power to relax any bye-laws of the Society.

Application of Act: 25.

All the provisions if GP Societies Registration Act, 2006 applicable to the state of HP shall apply to the Society

The President, General Body welcomed all the members and then agenda was taken up for discussion and decisions taken as under:-

I. Review of action taken on last meeting held on 5th August, 2010:

Regarding laundry work: Item No. 3 (ii):

Member Secretary of the Society intimated that quotation process of laundry work of Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli for the year 2011-2012 was completed after observing all codal formalities. The said workwas given to Sh. Ram Pal Kanaujia, Hotel Broad View, Sanjauli, Shimla-6 w.e.f. 1.4.2011 to 31.3.2012. After discussion in the matter and perusal of records the General Body approved the same. Hence this item stands dropped.

11. Maintenance and repair.

Member Secretary intimated that maintenance and repair of both buildings of Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli, Shimla is being carried out by the HPPWD. It was decided that the maintenance of building may be carried out as deposit work from HPPWD.

12. Revision of existing tariffs in view of higher rate of electricity/water charges etc.

Member Secretary of the Society submitted that presently one Manager, one Clerk and 3 Class-IV have been deployed by the Tribal Dev. Deptt. HP for the management, maintaining accounts/account books/receipt books/cash book/ledger/store and stock, housekeeping and other official work of the Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli. The pay and allowances etc. of above staff is being drawn by the Department from treasury as heretofore. The maintenance of Tribal Bhawan is also being carried out by the HPPWD as per past practice. Due to these reasons the Society was able to save Rs. 15,00,000/- approximately in the financial year 2010-2011 for the betterment of Society.

He further intimated that due to shortage of staff at Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli the Society is being outsourcing manpower for housekeeping work etc. for smooth functioning of Tribal Bhawan. Moreover, tariffs of water electricity etc. have also been increased by the concerned institutions. In view of position explained above it will be difficult for the Society to bear such more burden at its own. Whereas, monthly income of Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli is Rs. 1,50,000/- approximately. view of above position, Member Secretary placed a draft for revision of existing rates of Halls/rooms/dormitories of Tribal Bhawan, Dhalli.

After detailed discussions in the matter, for the betterment of Society, existing rates were unanimously re-fixed by all the members of General Body as per detail given below. These rates shall take effect from the date of issue of these proceedings:-
